- 4. Goalie Coaching: For goalies, VFC Mites provides specialized coaching during practices to develop essential skills.
- 5. Affordable & Flexible: The VFC program is known for being one of the most affordable options in the area, offering great value with a solid practice-to-game ratio and multi-player discounts.

#### **Tryout Information**

Any player in good standing can register for tryouts. Registration is first come first serve. A waiting list at all levels is possible, please register early. Tryouts are 3 days (2 days for Mite) Tryout dates and registration can be found at vfcolonials.com

There is a tryout fee of 100 [Mites = 0] which accompanies the online registration. This fee is separate from your tuition.
